



OPAF & The First Clinics Updates Summer 2011

- Hosted 15 First Clinics during June, July and August, with over 350 participants
- Launched First Climb, with close to 100 amputees attempting to climb a 25 foot rock wall. With First Climb, the total number of First Clinics offered is now eight
- Participated with three kids camps across the country for both orthotic and prosthetic patients
- Members of the OPAF Board of Directors visited the Center for the Intrepid and received a behind the scenes tour of the O & P facility
- Hosted a wheelchair/adapted tennis coaches workshop with USTA Missouri Valley Section
- Certified two more First Volley instructors, taking our national staff to 10
- Partnering with Otto Bock HealthCare for T.O.D.D. Field Day, an adaptive recreational day of events to honor Todd Anderson, CP, FAAOP
- Hosting ART in O & P at the OPAF booth as part of the AOPA National Assembly which will feature works of art from members of the O & P family, featuring both the art and science of our industry. All works available at auction
- Received multiple donations to the Dale Yasukawa Scholarship Fund to continue the legacy of Dale Yasukawa, CP
- Scheduling First Clinics into 2012 with both patient care facilities as well as grant funded events
- Received \$500 donation from Rockwell Collins for OPAF's contributions to health and wellness in the disabled community
- Over 10 First Clinics planned for fall 2011 across the country with a total of over 30 First Clinics this year
