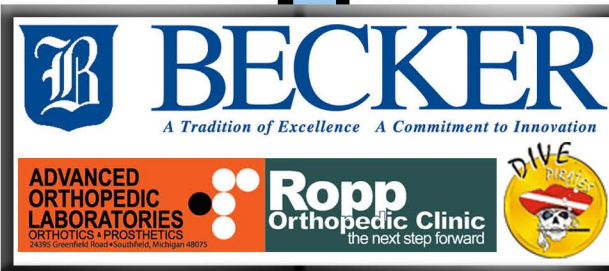
An Introduction To Paddling With Certified Instructors!
